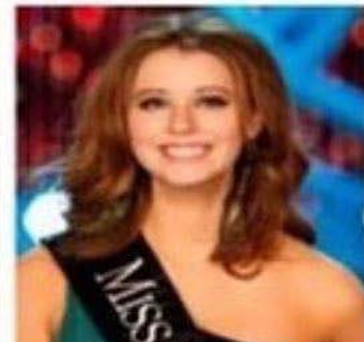

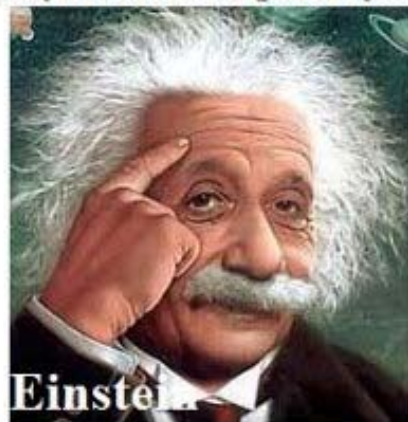


Stephen Wiltshire

Carly Fleischmann

Non-verbal with severe Autism, Dr.s predicted she wouldn't develop intellectually beyond the abilities of a small child. She now has profound conversations with others through her computer and has co-authored a book with her dad about her journey.

Didn't speak until age 4, was teased a lot and earmarked to be institutionalized. Now a writer and great speaker with a Phd.

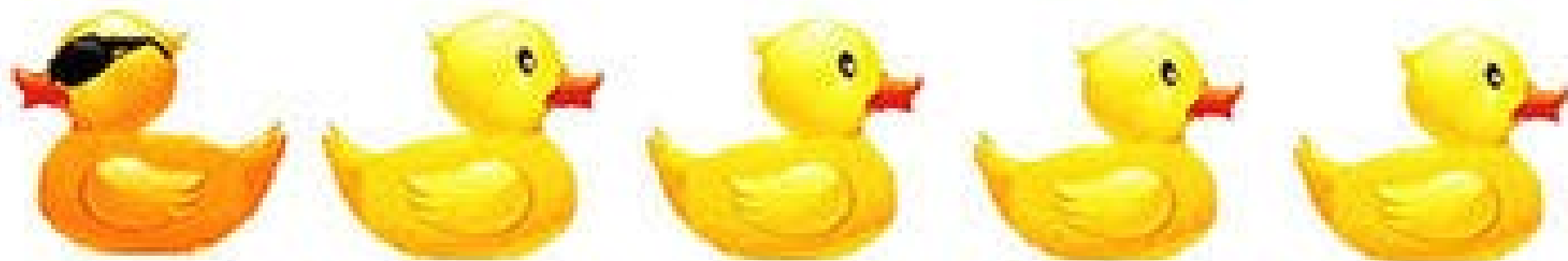
Jason McElwain
