

## 1929 – FOUR OLD BOYS FOUND THE ESSEMMAY ASSOCIATION

Fifty years after the opening of St. Margaret's, the Old Boys' Association was founded in 1929 by four pupils, Ian Bennett, Harold Corlett, Bert Graham and William Snowden. Their initial funds were nine pence! Within two years there were 150 members based at the Tyndall Hill Tennis Club in Tuebrook. Football and cricket teams were soon established and after the Second World War the Essemmay team joined the 3rd division of the I Zingari AFC League. In 1958 the team had reached the first division.

The Association began to admit girls in the 1980's as the co-educational Sixth Form expanded. Today it has its own website and uses information technology to the full.
