Access to Leeds Program

What is Access to Leeds?

The Access to Leeds scheme allows students to be identified who have the potential to succeed at the university but who may not be able to demonstrate their talents through grades alone. Eligible applicants who receive an offer from the University also receive an **Access to Leeds offer up to two A level grades (or equivalent) below their standard offer**. *For example, AAA is reduced to ABB*. The Access to Leeds alternative offer is conditional on the applicant making the University of Leeds their firm choice and successfully completing the Access to Leeds module.

The Access to Leeds module is launched at the end of March and will run until mid-July. Students have approximately six weeks to complete the first section, followed by a short break, then a further six weeks to complete the second element. The Access to Leeds team regularly communicates with applicants via email during the module. This module focuses on the development of essential study skills and provides an opportunity to complete work for the academic department the student hopes to study with.
