Are you aged 18 or over, and passionate about TV drama or comedy? If the answer is yes, then we have a very exciting opportunity for you!

The opportunity:

After completing a 7-day 'onboarding' workshop at the BBC Television Centre, London, you will start a paid 6-month placement with a TV production in drama or comedy. Your day-to-day activity will vary subject to the needs of the show, but you can expect to be:

- Working with a professional drama or comedy production team
- Working with the different departments such as props/art direction, sound, camera and the assistant director team (subject to requirements of the show)
- Assisting the movement of Supporting Artists (SAs) along with the 3rd Assistant Director
- Given the chance to gain more in-depth knowledge of all the other major areas such as script supervising, production co-ordinating and post-production
- Appointed a career mentor to help guide you into the area in which you are most interested.

You do not require previous production experience to apply for the programme; you will get plenty of hands-on experience on set, supervised by the production team. All we ask is that you are completely dedicated and committed throughout the entirety of programme. A runner will do everything from make the tea to printing off scripts! This is how most production staff got their break in TV/Film.

Applicants must not be in full time / part time education (this includes taking a gap year) or employment if accepted onto the programme. They must have been living in the UK for a minimum of a year and have indefinite leave to remain in the UK. You should also reside in the UK at the time of application and be aged 18+. Upon being notified of their successful acceptance onto the Programme, applicants must be able to serve notice with any current employer and vacate their current position by Sunday 27th February, in preparation for the Onboarding week.
