MUSIC DEPARTMENT

Instrumental music lessons are available for the academic year 2017-2018 and your son has expressed a wish to begin/continue instrumental tuition in school. If you wish him to take advantage of this facility, please complete the **MUSIC TUITION APPLICATION** on the envelope provided (even if you are paying online) and return to school immediately via your son.

The following fees are required **each term** for the instruments below (Sept 2017, **Jan 2018**, April 2018):

Instrumental timetables are provided by the peripatetic staff and can be found on the music notice board opposite the drama hall. It will be your son's responsibility to check his time from week to week and remember to attend his lesson on time. All instrumental lessons are twenty minutes long.

Please note that the lesson times will change from week to week to avoid students missing the same curriculum lessons, so it is imperative your son is organised about checking his lesson time at the beginning of the week. Lessons must be paid for if your son does not attend but you will not be charged for a lesson cancelled due to staff absence.

Please ensure that the appropriate fee is handed to the **school office** in the envelope provided. Fees can be paid via cheque, +pay or cash. Please make cheques payable to **St Margaret's Academy**. Please note that we are hoping to transition to online payments only as of September 2018. If there are any issues with this please do not hesitate to get in contact with myself or Miss Queen.

Music tuition will commence for your son on receipt of the appropriate fee.

Please note that a full term's notice must be given, in writing, if your son wishes to discontinue his instrumental tuition. Failure to do this will result in payment needed for unattended lessons.

Please note that all lessons are individual lessons unless agreed in advance with myself.
