A Level Geography Fieldwork Enquiry- Llandudno beach, Wales- Tuesday 13th March 2018

Year 12 students will be involved in a fieldwork course on Tuesday 13th March 2018 as part of their A level studies. They will undertake work preparing them for the examinations. Fieldwork and follow-up work will involve sampling methods, data collection, statistical analysis and the presentation and interpretation of findings, all of this information is necessary for the skills paper.

Students should wear outdoor clothing suitable for being exposed to the elements all day. Data collection should go ahead in spite of rain therefore; I would advise waterproof jacket and trousers and warm clothing should be brought. Students will also need writing equipment and a full packed lunch for the day. Cameras, mobile phones and other electronic may be brought, however, school cannot accept responsibility should they be lost or damaged, therefore, students do so at their own risk. The group will leave at 9am and should return to school by 4.30pm at the latest.

The prime consideration of fieldwork leaders is always the safety of the individual and the overall safety of the entire party and any decisions made or disciplinary action taken is to that end. On such outings we are all representatives of the school and the appropriate behaviour is expected. All of the usual necessary considerations regarding weather and location will be taken and included in our risk assessment. The successful outcome of the day's timetable depends on the active participation, cooperation and dedicated effort of the participants.
