Year 10 Trip to Alton Towers

For Fun Day this year we have organised a day trip to Alton Towers for Year 10 students on Monday 15th July 2019. Students will depart from school at 8.15 a.m. and arrive back in Aigburth at approximately 6.00 p.m. The trip will be subject to 70% uptake from the year group. Provided that all available places are taken up and in order for this excursion to go ahead, it will be necessary to ask for a payment of £32.00 per student, which includes transport and admission costs, which we believe is good value. To secure a place we will require a non-refundable deposit of £15.00 which must be paid via Parentmail +Pay no later than Tuesday 7th May 2019. The remainder of the payment will need to be paid by Monday 3rd June 2019 via Parentmail +Pay.

In line with our Charging Policy, pupils for whom we receive Pupil Premium funding (e.g. those entitled, or previously entitled, to Free School Meals) will not be required to make a payment for this trip. Please note that all payments must be made via ParentMail (+Pay). If you require any assistance with your account, please contact Miss Smith in the main school office.

Students will not need to wear school uniform and should bring enough food and/or money with them to last the day. There will be at least three members of staff on each coach. Once inside the theme park, the boys will be free to enjoy themselves unsupervised, knowing that a member of staff will always be available to them at a well-defined meeting place inside the park.
